Report on "Visit to Revolutionary Memorials at Kundal"

On 9 August 2025, a group of post-graduate students from the Department of History at Dr. Patangrao Kadam College, Ramanandnagar (Burli), visited an Revolutionary Memorials at Kundal. The PG students of the Department of History from Dr. Patangrao Kadam Mahavidyalaya, Ramanandnagar (Burli), accompanied by their faculty Prof. Mahale M.B., Prof. Kumbhar b.S. And Prof. Nalawade A. T., visited the Revolutionary Memorials in Kundal on 9 August 2025. The principal of the college Prof. Dr. U.V. Patil and Head of department Prof. Mahale M.B. guided for this activity. This visit provided the students with an opportunity to witness firsthand the historical significance of the weapons used by Shivaji Maharaj, as well as to deepen their understanding of his military strategies and leadership. The visit commenced at the **memorial of G.D. Bapu Lad**, a fearless leader known for his relentless struggle against British rule. Students observed the memorial site and learned about Bapu Lad's participation in the 1942 Quit India Movement and his role in mobilizing local resistance.

The group then proceeded to the **Krantisinh Nana Patil Memorial**, dedicated to the visionary leader who led the *Prati-Sarkar* (parallel government) in Satara during British rule. Through guided discussions and interpretative materials available at the site, students learned about Nana Patil's pioneering efforts to establish self-rule and his significant contribution to socio-political reform in the region.

The educational visit to Kundal proved to be both enlightening and inspiring. It enabled students to appreciate the rich legacy of local heroes like G.D. Bapu Lad and Krantisinh Nana Patil, who exemplified courage, leadership, and a vision for a free India. The trip successfully met its objectives and reaffirmed the importance of remembering and honoring the sacrifices of our freedom fighters.

- ❖ To connect classroom knowledge with field-based learning for a deeper historical insight.

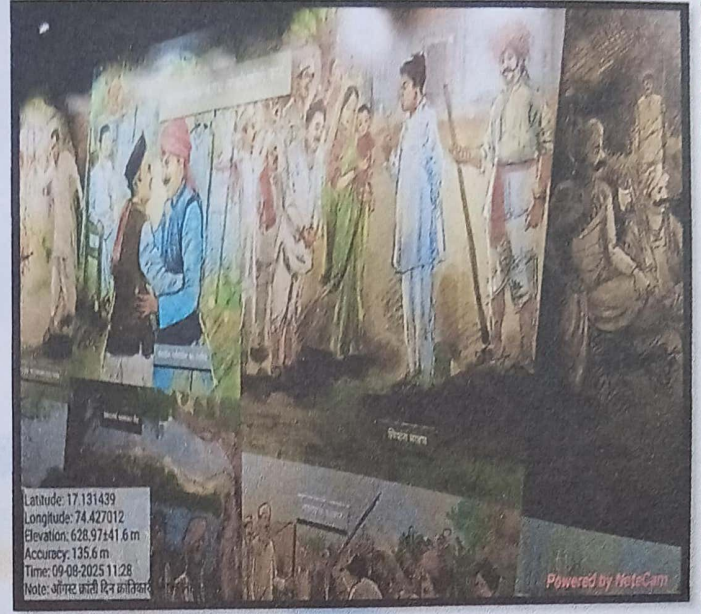
Learning Outcomes: During the visit, the students were able to:
