Dr. Patangrao Kadam Mahavidyalaya, Ramanandnagar (Burli) is a unit of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha established in June 1968. It is Affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur. This is the first college in Maharashtra State located in rural area. This College is recognized by the University Grant Commission under section 2(F) and 12(B) of UGC Act.1956. There are undergraduate courses Arts, Commerce and Science and a post-graduate course in History, English, Commerce and Analytical Chemistry. **The College has been re-accredited at A⁺⁺ grade with CGPA of 3.53 by NAAC Bangalore.**

2.3 Student from the other Universities:

- i) Student from the other Universities who seeks the admission has to follow the above norms, rules and conditions, in addition he/she should have to submit Migration Certificate of the previous University.
- ii) Such students have to apply for the provisional admission to the University and to the Principal.

१. सर्व विद्याशाखेतील पदवी अभ्यासक्रमाच्या प्रथम वर्षामध्ये घेतलेल्या तीन विषयांपैकी दुसऱ्या वर्षी १ मेजर व १ मायनर विषय विद्यार्थ्यांना निवडावे लागतील.
२. दुसऱ्या वर्षी निवडलेले मेजर व मायनर विषय तिसऱ्या वर्षी मेजर व मायनर म्हणून बंधनकारक राहतील.
३. ४. O.E पेपर १ ते O.E पेपर ५ हे एकाच विषयाचे असणे बंधनकारक नाही. ते वेगवेगळ्या विषयाचे असू शकतील.
५. SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) पेपर- १ ते SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) पेपर ४ एकाच किंवा वेगवेगळ्या विषयाचे निवडता येऊ शकतील.
६. VEC (Value Education Course) विषय अभ्यास मंडळे विभागाने निर्गमित केलेल्या नियमावली प्रमाणे असतील.
७. AEC (Ability Enhancement Course) हा इंग्रजी आवश्यक पेपर असेल.
८. इंडियन नॉलेज सिस्टम (IKS) प्रथम वर्षाच्या सर्व विद्यार्थ्यांना समान अभ्यासक्रमाचा (Generic) असेल. तथापि भाग - २ साठी IKS हा मेजर स्पेसिफिक असेल.
९. C.C (CO-Curricular Course) च्या विद्यार्थ्यांनी ६० तासांचा कार्यभार पूर्ण करणे आवश्यक आहेत.
१०. CEP (Commnity Engagement Program), C.C (Co-curricular Course), F.P (Field Project) आणि R.P (Research Project) याबाबत विद्यापीठाने निर्गमित केलेल्या नियमानुसार कार्यवाही करावी. CEP चे ६० तासांचा कार्यभार पूर्ण करणे आवश्यक असून केलेल्या कामाची डायरी आणि प्राजॅक्ट रिपोर्ट विद्यार्थ्यांनी तयार करणे बंधनकारक आहे.
११. F.P (Field Project), C.E.P, O.J.T, R.P हे मेजर विषयाशी संबंधित असतील.
१२. OJT (On Job Training/Internship/Apprentiship) याबाबत शिवाजी विद्यापीठाने लागू केलेल्या धोरणानुसार कार्यवाही करावयाची आहे.

१३. Skill Enhancement Courses चे Assessment करणेसाठी विद्यापीठाच्या NEP Regulation २.० नुसार Skill Assessment Board ची स्थापना करण्यात यावी.

१९. तीन वर्षांची पदवी प्राप्त केलेल्या विद्यार्थ्यांना पदव्युत्तर पदवीच्या प्रथम वर्षात प्रवेश घेता येईल.
२०. पदव्युत्तर पदवीचे प्रथम वर्ष पूर्ण झालेनंतर विद्यार्थी बाहेर (Exit) पडणार असेल तर त्याला उन्हाळी सुटटीतील चार श्रेयांकाचा व्यावसायिक अभ्यास किंवा कौशल्य वृद्धी अभ्यास पूर्ण करावा लागेल. त्यानंतर त्याला पदव्युत्तर पदविका (Post Graduate Diploma) मिळू शकेल.
